UPDATE ON RESPONSES FROM AIRPORT IMPROVEMENT SURVEY

Gary Crecelius, Director of Planning & Development, informed the Board that the Airport Improvement Surveys have been mailed out and thirty-five responses have been received, with this number including responses received by the City prior to the mass mailing.

Chairman Stewart indicated that he was disappointed in the number of responses, however, according to his count, these surveys indicated more than 800 additional operations which exceeds the required 500 operations for expansion of the Athens Municipal Airport. Chairman Stewart thanked the City staff for all of the work they have done.

Member Grant stated that he would contact the Athens Chamber of Commerce and Athens Economic Development Corporation about emailing the Athens Municipal Airport Business Survey to members and business contacts.
